SRPC Regional Data Snapshot

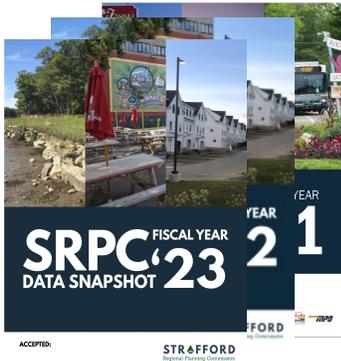
This document is a component of the SRPC Regional Data Snapshot.

SRPC conducts region-wide analysis of a number of data metrics each year for different projects and plans. The Regional Data Snapshot was a new document in 2021, and updated in April of each year, that contains many of these analyses in one place. 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





Educational Attainment of Adults








**Fatal Crashes




