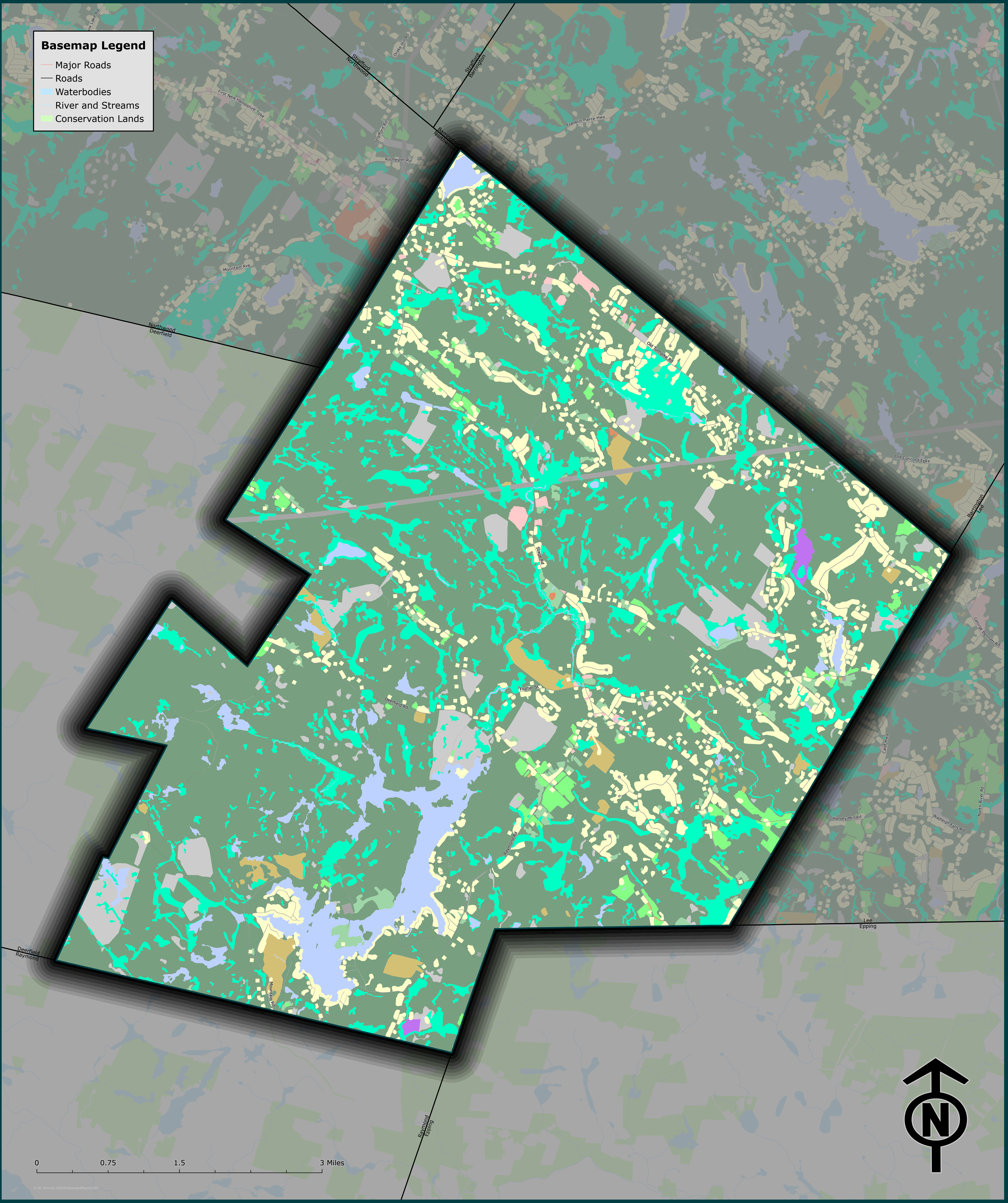


Nottingham, New Hampshire: Land Use

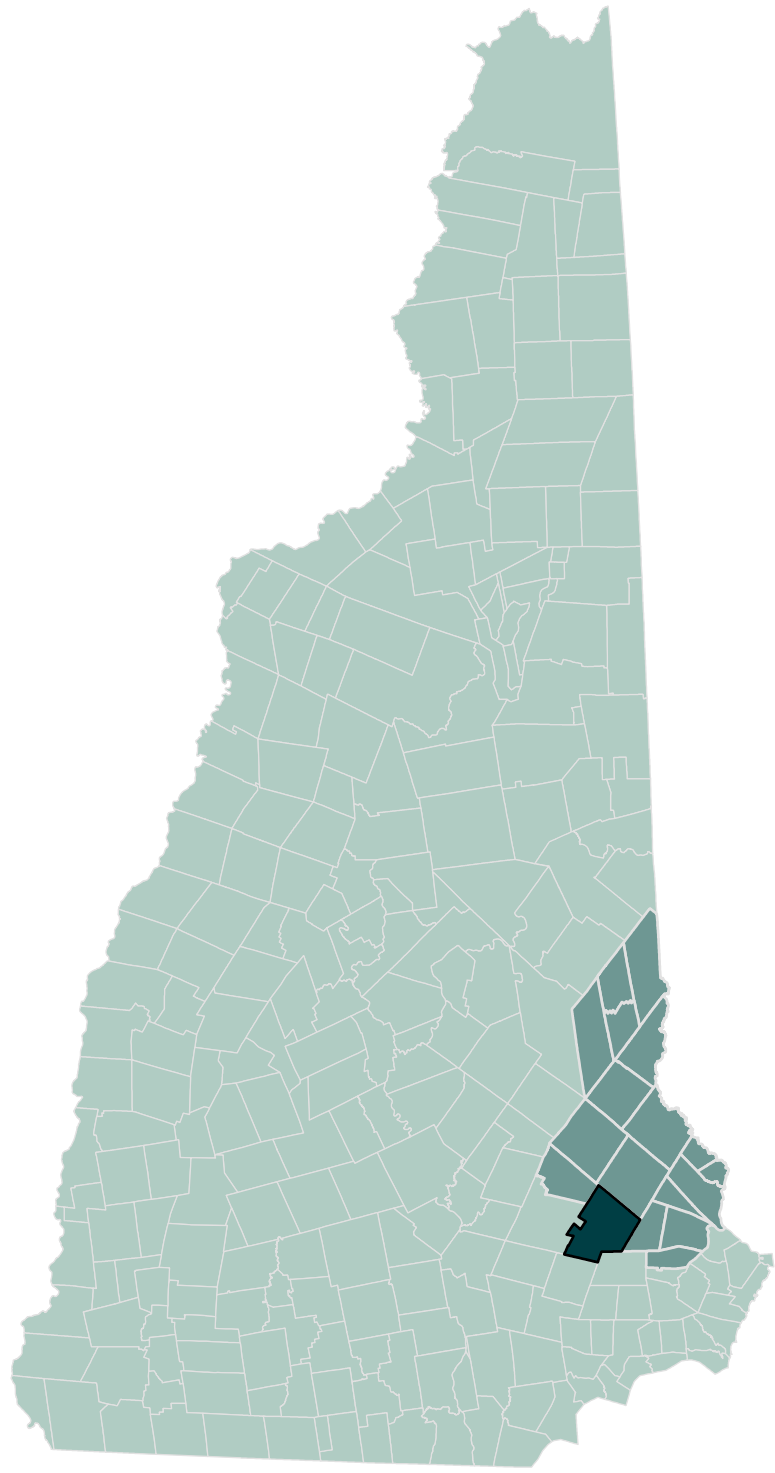
